

STABILIZATION RESERVE FUND & DISTRIBUTION POLICY

The Stabilization Reserve Fund facilitates planning and further solidifies the long-term sustainibility of the POINT AFTER CLUB.

With the Stabilization Reserve Fund in a healthy position, the distribution policy of the POINT AFTER CLUB is unchanged. In 2025, annual donations will be allocated, as follows:

- 50% to Athletic Financial Awards
- 15% to Leadership & Development
- 15% to Recruiting & Communications
- 15% to StFX For Campus Projects
- 5% to Stabilization Reserve Fund
